

ST. IGNACE TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING
January 8, 2020

The regular meeting of the St. Ignace Township Board was held on January 8, 2020 at the Township Hall. Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Campbell.

Present: Supervisor Campbell, Clerk Oja, Treasurer Massey, Trustee McKenzie, Trustee Mitchell

Absent: None

Public comment: Terry Becker and his wife, who reside on Simmons Road, were present with their concerns about the big trucks coming from the gravel pit and logging trucks, constantly going by their house and the weight restrictions for them. He has voiced his concern at a Mackinac County Road Commission meeting and was told to go to the township. He has been in contact with Supervisor Campbell regarding this issue. Supervisor Campbell stated the Simmons Road needs to be resurfaced, and possibly repaved, as it is in very bad shape. Much of this is due to the truck traffic. As the ownership of Simmons Road is half St. Ignace township and half Marquette township, there will need to be more information on how this can be done. Mr. Becker also addressed his concerns about a woman living at N5584 Simmons road who has many dogs and apparently is living in a trailer, with no septic. The board will look into who to contact and what can or may be done regarding this issue and get back to Mr. Becker.

Mark Wilk was also present with an update on the Ambulance contract. A final draft of the contract should be available to be presented at the February board meeting.

Clerk Oja presented the minutes for the December 11, 2019 Regular meeting. Motion by Mitchell, supported by Massey, to accept the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer Massey presented the Treasurers report for December. Motion by McKenzie, supported by Campbell, to accept the Treasurers report. Motion carried.

Clerk Oja submitted the expenses for approval. This amount does not include a Cloverland Electric bill that was not received prior to the meeting. Clerk Oja will pay the bill after the meeting and have an amended expense report for January at the next meeting.
