The regular meeting of the St. Ignace Township Board was held on June 9, 2021 at the Township Hall. Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Danielson.

He was informed by the State on how the process of the Building Inspector works and that all complaints are looked into by the state, it just takes longer. He was also told by the State that the Massey Fish Market in Evergreen Shores has done building without building permits. The state is investigating that as well.
