

ST. IGNACE TOWNSHIP REGULAR MEETING MINUTES
September 8, 2021

The regular meeting of the St. Ignace Township Board of Trustees was held on September 8, 2021, at the Township Hall. Meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Danielson.

Present: Supervisor Danielson, Treasurer Massey, Clerk Oja, Trustee Mitchell, Trustee McKenzie

Public Comment: Kathryn Becker thanked the board for the township newsletter and corrected her address.

Clerk Oja submitted the minutes for the August 11, 2021, regular meeting. Motion by Danielson, supported by McKenzie, to accept the minutes as presented. Motion carried.

Treasurer Massey presented the Treasurers Report for August. Motion made by McKenzie, supported by Mitchell, to accept the Treasurers report as presented. Motion carried.

Zoning Administrator Report: Zoning Administrator Garen updated the Board on the two pending complaints that he has sent notices on. The owner of the property on Mackinac Trail lives in Canada and said he can't come over to take care of it until the border opens. Mr. Garen stated the garage at the property has burned down and there is a bunch of debris there now, which may make it a dangerous building. The Board needs to determine where to go from here on that property, as well as the other complaint on M-28 of a property owner selling tiny houses without a permit.

Clerk Oja submitted the September expenses for approval:

Motion by Mitchell, supported by Massey, to accept the expenses as submitted. Motion carried.

Old Business: Supervisor Danielson attended the ambulance board meeting. Most townships have agreed to pay for the new ambulance, at a cost of approximately \$35,000. Mr. Wilk will let the board know whether the payment must be made in full or can be made in payments.

New Business: The Board will meet at the township cemetery on September 22, 2021 at 6 pm to review the current township maps for additions or corrections. Clerk Oja will be attending a cemetery management class on Sept. 14th and will bring back what recommendations or documentation from that class.

Correspondence: Supervisor Danielson received a letter from a property owner on Jamison Road that would like to have the road made into a private road, due to theft and vandalism and persons on the property trespassing. This would be a road commission issue. Supervisor Danielson also received a complaint from a township resident that lives on Lant Road about cars driving down that road that may think it is the highway. There is currently a dead end sign on that road.

Motion made by Danielson, supported by Mitchell to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 7:19 p.m.
